### **Schedule C Environmental Study**

#### **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**

#### **Construction of New Water Supply Well and Treatment Facility, Durham Water Works, West Grey**

The Municipality of West Grey has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment to address shortfall in rated capacity of Durham Water Works, which will occur due to new subdivision developments in Durham. The rated capacity of Water Works will be exceeded if additional water supply source and water treatment capacity is not expanded. Furthermore, hydrogeological assessment indicated that existing water supply wells yield was on decline and there was a risk relating to the supply of water to water customers in sufficient quantity.

West Grey planned this project under **Schedule C** of the **Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**. The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, the Municipality intends to proceed with the commissioning of New Well #1C and upgrading of Well #1B Pumping House and Treatment Works to treat additional raw water supply from Well #1C.
