The Municipality of West Grey is undertaking a review and amending its current Zoning Bylaw to allow detached additional dwelling units in residential zones, to reduce minimum floor area requirements for dwellings, to rezone all R1B properties to R2, and to allow the Natural Environment zone to be used in the calculation of minimum lot area.
