

The Corporation of the Municipality of West Grey Mayoral Decision No. 2025-004

Decision to shorten the 10-day veto period associated with the 2026 Mayor's Budget to one day.

WHEREAS Section 284.16 of Part VI.1 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 assigns powers and duties with respect to proposing and adopting a budget to the Head of Council; and

WHEREAS Subsection 7(6) of Ontario Regulation 530/22 provides that the Head of Council may veto a resolution passed by Council to amend the proposed budget within 10 days after the expiry of the time period for Council to pass such a resolution; and

WHEREAS Subsection 7(7) of Ontario Regulation 530/22 provides that the Head of Council may, in a year, shorten the 10-day veto period by providing to each member of Council and to the Clerk a written document specifying a shorter period;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority granted under Section 284.16(4) of the *Municipal Act, 2001* and section 7(7) of Ontario Regulation 530/22:

I, Kevin Eccles, Mayor of the Municipality of West Grey, hereby decide to shorten the 10-day veto period referred to in Subsection 7(6) of Ontario Regulation 530/22 to one day after the expiry of the time period for Council to pass a resolution under Subsection 7(3) of the Regulation.

This decision takes effect immediately and applies to the 2026 budget cycle.
