## Voters List

## Voting Methods

Internet and telephone voting are the voting methods for the 2026 Municipal Election. You will be able to cast your vote from the comfort of your home or anywhere you can access the internet or a telephone, including at election centres.

## Voter Information Letters

Voter information letters will be mailed out in October. Letters will have voting instructions and a unique PIN to log in to the election website or telephone election platform.



## Who can vote?

Any person who on Election Day, Monday, October 26, 2026, meets the following qualifications is eligible to vote in the Municipality of West Grey Municipal Election:

- Is a Canadian citizen.
- Is at least 18 years old.
- Resides in the Municipality of West Grey, or is the owner or tenant of land in the Municipality, or the spouse of such a person.
- Is not prohibited by law from voting.

## What do I need to vote?

Voters need to have a voter information letter in order to vote.

This will be mailed to you in October. This letter will have your instructions and your unique Personal Identification Number, required to log on to the internet election site or the telephone election platform. For more information, please visit [westgreylvotes.com](http://westgreylvotes.com)

## What devices can I use to vote?

Voters can use any device that connects to the internet, including computers, tablets, and smartphones. Voters can also use touch-tone telephones. Rotary phones may not be used.

**There will be no paper ballots for this election.**



## Retirement and Long-term Care Homes

Retirement and long-term care homes will host election centres during the voting period. The dates and times of election centres at these facilities will be confirmed before the voting period and posted at each location.
